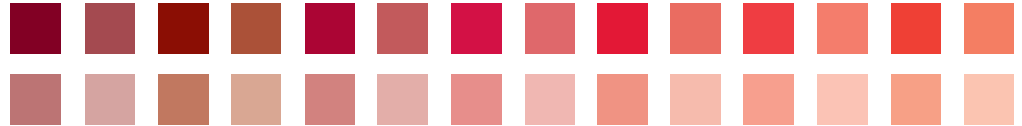
Your guide to colours
